

Martinstag Laterne

1. Print the following two pages (2-3), using double-sided printing (flip on long edge).
2. Children can color in the images.
3. Turn paper over. Cut along solid line. Save strip of paper for the lantern handle.
4. Fold in half along thick dashed line.
5. Cut along small dotted lines. Don't cut all the way through!
6. Now fold the paper back the other way, so that the images are showing.
7. Open the paper and connect the short end of the paper with staples, tape, or glue to form a cylinder.
8. Attach the strip to two sides of the top opening to form a handle.

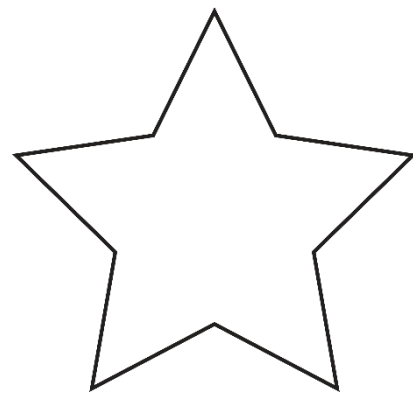
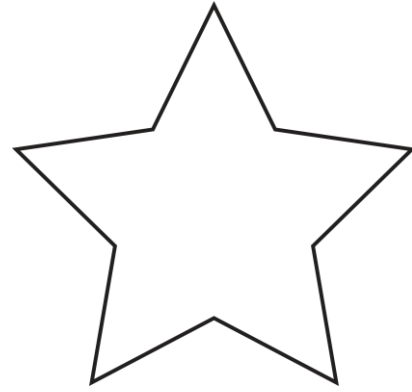
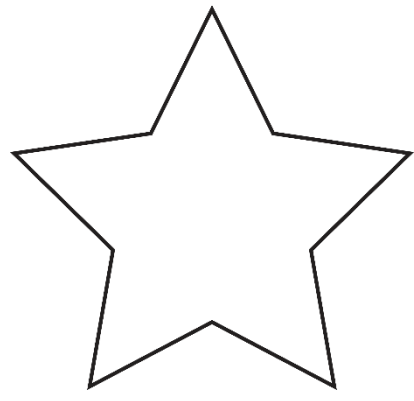
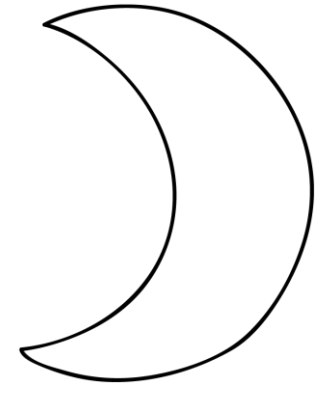
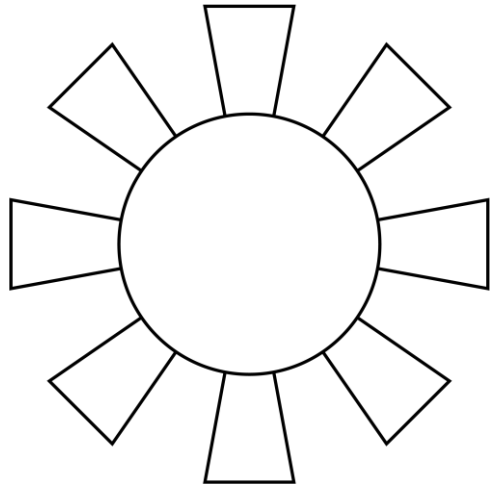
