

Meine Kürbislaterne mit Formen

Use basic shapes to create a Halloween jack-o-lantern!

Materials:

- Orange paper plates (or large pumpkin-shaped paper)
- shapes: circles, squares, triangles (can be colored or black)
- glue stick



Instructions:

1. Punch or cut out shapes (unless you are lucky enough to find some at a craft store!)
2. Use the worksheet to decide which shapes will be eyes, nose, and mouth. Choose a different shape for each part of the face. For example: two triangle eyes, one square nose, three circles to make the mouth.
3. Glue the shapes on to the plate to make the face of your jack-o-lantern!
4. You can use the second page as a coloring page/handout. I printed the two pages double-sided.

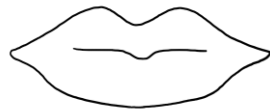

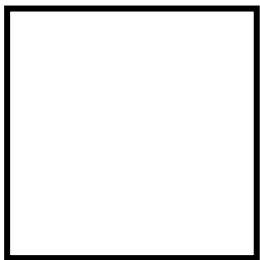
